



## **Ray of Hope Outreach Ambassador**

The Ray of Hope Outreach Ambassador is a volunteer position responsible for representing the foundation at community awareness events and information sessions.

### **Timing & Commitment**

- Attend a 1 hour Ambassador training
- Monthly commitment of 1 to 10 hours, depending on preference
- Volunteering will take place on an as needed basis
- Exact timing based on volunteer's availability

### **Location**

- Various locations around Colorado
- Ambassadors (in the Denver area) may be asked to pick up materials at the Ray of Hope Cancer Foundation office (3455 Ringsby Court #111 Denver, CO 80216)
- Ambassadors will be responsible for personal transportation to/from volunteering

### **Duties**

- Setup Ray of Hope Cancer Foundation table and materials at events
- Share information about Foundation grants, programs, events, and donor levels
- Share foundation stories, including personal story (if willing)
- Breakdown materials and return leftover materials to foundation office

### **Required Skills**

- Good communication skills and willingness to talk with strangers
- Ability to lift up to 15 lbs. and ability to stand for long periods of time
